The fire hall has been used a place of refuge during disasters, such as snowstorms, power outages and flooding. The hall was a major place for people to stay during the 1977 Johnstown Flood.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
